Winter Session (January 8 – March 23, 2018)

- ❖ Registration will open Wednesday, December 6, 2017. Online registrations will happen in real time beginning at 7:00 PM. Paper registrations will be processed at the end of each school day during registration - please turn in to the front office. Online registration will close on Wednesday, December 13, 2017 at 5:00 PM.
- ❖ Classes will close once they reach their capacity. You will receive prompt notification if you have registered for a class that has already filled, usually within one day.
- ❖ Registration is open to children in K – 5th grades, though not all classes are appropriate for all ages. Please check class descriptions carefully.
- ❖ Classes will start at **2:30 PM** and run until **3:30 PM**; on early release Wednesdays, classes run back-to-back from **1:15 – 2:30 PM** and **2:30 – 3:45 PM**, unless otherwise noted.* Hiawatha staff will pick up Aftercare students who attend enrichment classes at 3:30 PM and walk them to the Schmitz Park site. There will be only one pick up at 2:30 PM on early release Wednesdays. Aftercare students assigned to the Schmitz Park site should not enroll in classes that end after the scheduled pick up time(s). **Note: Chess (3-5) will end at 2:15 PM and Wilderness Awareness will run until 3:15 PM.*
- ❖ Registrations received after the closing date will be processed on a first come/first served basis, as space allows.
- ❖ Parents will receive an email confirmation of enrollment prior to the start of the session. If a student is waitlisted for a class, parents will receive an email with information regarding their options.
- ❖ **THE PTA REQUIRES 2 TO 3 ADULT VOLUNTEERS TO ACT AS CHAPERONES FOR ENRICHMENT CLASSES.** Volunteers receive priority enrollment and reduced/free tuition for their child(ren) for any class offered on the day(s) they volunteer. 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Art Wizards – Everyone Can Draw!	Grades K - 5	Tuesdays to 3:30 PM
<p>Art Wizards is a unique fine arts program based on the belief that every child can learn to draw. The most important part of learning to draw is learning to see. That's where we start. We give students all the information they need to be successful, but not so much that we stifle their imagination or limit their opportunities. With consistent and ongoing practice throughout the school year, our students are amazed at the progress they make. Projects include fish, birds and animals of all kinds; people, landscapes, still life, mythical creatures, movie characters and cartoons (including Minecraft, Pokemon, Smurfs, Cars 3, Leap!, The Nut Job and the Lego Batman Movie). We show them how to break down a scene or character so it comes out looking like what they intended. We show them how easy it can be when they know how to use chalk and oil pastels, when it's better to use colored pencils and where markers and watercolor fit in. It's easy! It's exciting! Students must be picked up no later than 10 minutes after the scheduled class end time, except when a class has indicated it runs longer. If there is a problem with pickup, please be in contact with the instructor or arrange to have another parent pick up your child. If you are more than 10 minutes late you will be required to pay a late fee of \$1.00 per minute. Parents that are chronically late may be unable to register for classes in the future.

Classes with maximum class sizes will be first come, first served. The exception to this will be the instructor's or enrichment coordinator's own children. All efforts will be made to create space for all children.

A class may be completely cancelled if the minimum number of students is not reached.

Classes/Clubs are chosen for the needs of community. New classes and clubs are always sought and can apply to the Enrichment Program for review.

Cancellation Policy: If you cancel registration 48 hours before the session begins, you may receive a full refund. If you cancel within the 48 hours, or during the session, there will be no guarantee of refund.
